

Welcome to our herd!



On Thursday, November 12, the Miami-Dade County Zoning Commissioners heard Whispering Manes' petition to re-zone our new property as a riding academy. Thanks to our zoning attorney, Felix Lasarte of the Lasarte Law Firm, and over a dozen neighbors, volunteers, parents, and one of the riders in our program, the commissioners heard our case and voted unanimously to re-zone the land so that Whispering Manes can now operate as a riding academy (meaning we can finally start teaching) at our beautiful new facility. This night was the culmination of 11 months of hard work and brings us one step closer to truly calling the new barn home. We have to be patient for just a little longer while all of the paperwork goes through the right offices and gets signed by the right people, but we hope to start teaching under the roof of our new arena with the start of 2016!



Thank you to all of our supporters who came to the zoning hearing, signed our petition, and took our petition to their schools, offices, and friends. We ended up with over 300 signatures of support!
